### **Terms & Conditions**

Before booking on any of Mountviews Short/Online courses please ensure you have read and understood these Terms and Conditions.

By booking a place on a course you confirm that you have read, understood and agree with the Terms and Conditions.

### Fees:

All course fees are non-refundable or transferable and must be paid in full before the start of a course.

# Withdrawing for a Course:

Once a place on the course has been accepted and fees have been processed, if you choose to withdraw your application notice must be received in writing;

- No later than 14 days before commencement of the course to receive a 90% refund.
- No later than 7 days before commencement of the course to receive a 66 % refund.
- After 7 days before the start date of the course no monies will be refunded and the full course fees will still apply.

### **Course cancellation;**

In some instances, due to circumstances beyond our control, we may need to cancel or postpone a course. In this event any course fees would be reimbursed, however Mountview cannot be held responsible for additional expenses incurred by the student. These may include purchase of equipment, the cost of airfares, hotels or any other expenses incurred by the student.

In the event of a course being cancelled once it has started a relevant % of course fees would be refunded to cover any training not taking place.

If a student chooses to leave a course before its completion full course fees would still apply.
