The background

Little Tanks after school drama was established by Debi Rush and has been successfully running and growing for the past 20 years. The clubs are based in primary schools and work as an enrichment for schools that choose to pioneer extra-curricular activities at no cost or management from the school.

Children of various ages from 5-11 years can attend the clubs for a termly fee to help build confidence and communication skill as well as working towards a small-scale production to be performed to the parents at the end of the term.

The performance will be a short script created collaboratively by Little Tanks and the tutor of what the children have been working on for the term. Props, costume and music are supplied by Little Tanks to further engage the children and therefore enhance the performance to be a positive experience for all.

The courses are designed to encourage children to express themselves through drama, develop confidence and enjoy an after-school activity that is creative and lots of fun.

The brief

Aims of the program:

- To work with the children in producing a short 5-10 minute performance at the end of term
- Encourage children to develop confidence skills
- Encourage children to develop communication skills

Selection Criteria

Applicants will need to demonstrate:

- Running the sessions using your own expertise and experience
- Planning weekly lessons
- Assist children with any problems that occur
- Instill and build confidence in the pupils
- Be professional and respectful always towards the children
- Set tasks for the children to carry out
- Carry out behaviour management procedures
- Ensure children are having fun
- Carry out effective safeguarding procedures
- · Keep confidential information about the children and the company confidential
- Be mindful of current situations and be on hand to work in a flexible manner to suit the needs of the pupils, school and Little Tanks Company.
- Be responsible for ensuring that each duty is carried out fully and to the best of your ability
- Full training will be given to the right candidate if experience is limited
