**JOB TITLE:** Generation Next Facilitator – Musical Director (West End Workshop)

Mountview's flagship programme for young people, **Generation Next** offers confidence and skills-building workshops for young people aged 6 – 18, mainly on Saturdays, in school term-time. A bursary scheme supports access to this initiative. We are currently looking to expand our pool musical directors for our West End Workshop teams in advance of autumn 2024 term.

### PERSON SPECIFICATION

**Mountview expects that someone who is suitable to work with young people will be:**

- Passionate about creating safe environments where young people can be creative.
- A good listener and an effective communicator.
- Proactive and attentive regarding the safety of young people.
- Calm, patient and confident.
- Good at building working relationships with others and being part of a team.
- Able to see and consider different perspectives and lead diverse groups of young people.

### KEY RESPONSIBILITIES (MD-specific and general)

- Plan and deliver workshops for young people, liaising with co-facilitators about content selection.
- Imaginatively encourage young people through stage and age-appropriate vocal exercises.
- Support the delivery of games and group-work.
- Provide training and skills-building in relevant areas.
- Guide young people in generating original material where appropriate.
- Assist with attendance records at each session and flagging continuous lateness or absence to the Participation Administrator for follow-up.
- Equip yourself with source materials for workshops (including sheet music), with support from the Participation Administrator, ensuring timely printing requests.
- Ensure spaces are safe and suitable for workshops on entry.
- Be responsible for the safety and welfare of young people attending workshops – following Mountview's Safeguarding and Child Protection policies and procedures.
- Involvement in the planning, facilitation and delivery of showcase performances.
- Liaise with other departments in the building to ensure smooth running of Generation Next.
- Attend termly training and feedback sessions led by the Participation department.

Generation Next runs in three terms of ten weeks alongside the academic calendar with a break of one week in the middle of each term.

**Autumn term dates:** Sat 21<sup>st</sup> Sept – Sat 30<sup>th</sup> Nov 2024 (half-term break – 2<sup>nd</sup> November)

Facilitators are required to be able to commit to the project for the whole term, to ensure consistency for the young participants.
